Stage I Fire Restrictions

The following are prohibited on the state and private forestland and rangeland, and on public land, roads, and trails until further notice:

- 1. Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire except within a designated recreation site, within a fire structure provided by the administrative agency, or on their own land and only within an owner-provided fire structure (see definition below)
- 2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area at least three feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable materials.

Exemptions

- 1. Persons with a written permit that specifically authorizes the otherwise prohibited act.
- 2. Persons using fire fueled solely by liquid petroleum or LPG fuels.
- 3. Persons conducting activities in those designated areas where the activity is specifically authorized by written posted notice.
- 4. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.
- 5. All land within a city boundary is exempted
- 6. Other exemptions unique to each agency

Violation of the above prohibited acts is punishable by fine of not more that \$1,000 and/or imprisonment for not more than 12 months (Title 18 USC 1856, Title 43 USC 1701, Title 43 9212.4, and/or appropriate State laws).
