**WEATHER HIGHLIGHT**

Temperatures were in the 90s with many areas in the 100s. Temperatures along the coast were in the 60s and 70s. Much of the east side saw relative humidity values in the single digits to low teens. The west side had relative humidity values in the 20s. Poor relative humidity recoveries were seen in most locations. Winds were light with gusts into the teens and 20s. There was no precipitation or lightning. Initial attack activity was light. The Larch Creek fire grew to 7,000 acres.
