WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures were in the upper 90s to 100s on the east side, 80s and 90s on the west side, and 60s along the coast, Much of the east side had RH values in the teens with occasional single digits. The west side generally had RHs in the 20s. Poor RH recoveries were seen east of the Cascades. Winds were generally light with some stations having gusts up to 30. There was no precipitation or lightning. Initial attack was moderate. The River Fire grew 2,500.
