WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures continued to be in the upper 90s to 100s on the east side, 80s and 90s on the west side, and 60s along the coast. Relative humidities on the east side were in the teens with some locations dropping into the singles digits. West side relative humidities were in the 20s and 30s. Wind gust in southeast Oregon were in the 30s and light to breezy in other locations. There was no precipitation and lightning was light. The 0404 RV Lone Rock fire grew to 5,000 acres.
