WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures near the coast were in the 60s, in the 90s across much of the east side and in the 80s and 90s on the west side. Relative humidities were in the teens on the east side, and high 20s to the 40s on the west side. Winds were light to breezy with gusts generally in the 20s. Initial attack activity was light. There was some scattered precipitation in southwest Oregon and lightning was light with 105 strikes across the GACC. The Wallace Walker Fire grew to 561 acres.
