WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Morning clouds along the coast gave way to sunny afternoon skies. Much of the Columbia Basin experienced temperatures in the 90s and 100s, while other areas on the west side were in the 90s. To the east of the Cascades temperatures were in the 80s with 60s and 70s along the coast. Relative humidity on the west side was in the 20s to 40s, teens and 20s scattered single digits east. Winds were light with gust in the 20s. No precipitation was received, and lightning was light across the geographic area. Initial attack activity was light. The CR Jackpine fire grew to 180 acres/ CIMT orders processed for Moss Mountain incident and Homestead Complex (CIMT GB Team 5).

BMIDC Fire Activity

Monkey Creek. OR-PRD-050265. ICT4. 13 Miles SW of Ukiah, OR. Start 7/18. Full Suppression. Cause: Undetermined. 1,400 acres (+1,000). 15% Containment. Timber and grass. Active fire behavior with wind driven runs, torching and flanking. Evacuations in effect.

Jack Canyon Mutual Aid. OR-973S-000224. OSFM Green Team. 4 Miles SW of Pilot Rock, OR. Start 7/17. Full Suppression. Cause: Undetermined. 19,000 acres (+0). 94% containment. Grass and brush. Minimal fire behavior.

Battle Mountain Complex. OR-973S-000250. ODF Team 3. West of Ukiah, OR. Start 7/17. Full Suppression. Cause: Undetermined/ 3,750 total acres. (+1,964). 0% containment. Timber. Extreme fire behavior.
