WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Morning clouds west of the Cascades led to sunny skies across the area. Along the coast temperatures were in the mid to upper 60s. Other west side locations were mostly in the mid-70s. East of the Cascades continued to be in the mid to upper 90s with a few temperatures in the 100s. Humidities remained in the 30-40s west of the Cascades and teens to 20s east of the Cascades. Winds were gusty, as high as 40 mph in the wind prone areas east of the Cascades. Scattered precipitation was received with storms. Light to moderate lightning occurred in eastern Oregon. Initial attack was heavy. The Big Horn fire grew to 15,000 acres.
