**WEATHER HIGHLIGHT**

Smoky skies over central Oregon and morning clouds along the coast gave way to clear afternoon skies across most of the Pacific Northwest. Temperatures were mid-60s to mid-80s west of the Cascades, and mostly mid-80s east of the Cascades. Humidities were mostly in the mid-teens east of Cascades; while western areas were in the mid-30s while 50-70% along the coast. Winds were light with the strongest gusts in the 30s along the usual Cascade gaps. Initial attack was light with the largest new start in northeastern Oregon. Isolated lightning in southeastern Oregon and northern Washington.
