WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Clouds covered the geographic area bringing moderate precipitation to western Washington. Scattered precipitation fell across the remainder of the geographic area. Temperatures west of the Cascades remained in the 60s while the east side and southwest Oregon rose to the 70-80s. Conditions were very windy on the east side gusting to 40 mph. Isolated lightning in central and northeastern Oregon. Initial attack was light with the largest new fire in the fine fuels in southeastern Washington. Existing large fires showed moderate growth.
