**WEATHER HIGHLIGHT**

Temperatures were in the 60-70s across the west side and 70s to low 90s across the east side and southern Oregon. Relative humidity dipped down into the 20s in basins on the east side. Winds were breezy across the geographic area with gusts up to 35 mpg in southeast Oregon and the Columbia Gorge. Scattered precipitation fell in western Washington and northern Oregon. No lightning recorded. Initial attack was light with the largest new start reaching 200 acres in grass in south central Washington. Weather conditions moderated fire behavior on existing large fires.
