WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures across the Geographic Area were in the 80-90s. Relative humidity east of the Cascades and in southwest Oregon dropped into the teens while west of the cascades stayed above the mid-30s. Overnight humidity recovery was moderate on the east slopes of the Washington Cascades and in basins of eastern Oregon. Lightning was light and accompanied with scattered precipitation across northern and central Washington. Winds were breezy with strong outflow gusts in the mid-40s in northern and central Washington. Initial attack was moderate with northern Washington receiving the majority of the new starts. Existing large fires continued to see active fire behavior.
