WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures were in the 80s to low 90s across the Geographic Area. Relative humidities east of the Cascades were in the teens and 20s, west of the Cascades humidities remained above 30 percent. Breezy conditions were widespread across the area. Lightning occurring this morning along the east slopes of the Cascades north of Leavenworth, Washington to the Canadian border is accompanied by scattered wetting rain, isolated lightning strikes were recorded north of Ontario, Oregon. Initial attack was light. Existing large fires continued to exhibit active fire behavior.
