WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures remained in the 80s to low 90s east of the Cascades and high 60s to low 70s west of the Cascades. Minimum relative humidities were in the teens and 20s in eastern Oregon and the Columbia Basin. In the Cascades and west, humidities were above 40 percent. Breezy conditions were widespread across the area with windy conditions through the Cascade gaps. Lightning occurred across northern Washington and in Oregon on a line from Klamath Falls through Enterprise. Scattered light to moderate precipitation accompanied storms in northern Washington and in eastern Oregon the thunderstorms were dry in the south with scattered light precipitation further north. Initial attack was light. Existing large fires exhibited moderate to active fire behavior.
