High temperatures lowered to the 70s to low 80s east of the Cascades and remained in the 60s to low 70s west of the Cascades. Minimum relative humidities east of the Cascades were in the 20s and 30s except in southeast Oregon where they ranged from 10 to the high teens. West of the Cascades minimum humidities were above 30 percent. Winds were breezy with gusty conditions occurring in southeast Oregon and through the Cascade gaps. Lightning occurred in southeast, northeast Oregon and north central Washington. Scattered light to heavy rainfall occurred in northeast Oregon, storms elsewhere produced scattered light precipitation. Initial attack was light.
