WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures were in the 70-80s across the western Washington and northwest Oregon while relative humidities stayed above 40 percent. The remainder of the geographic area recorded temperatures in the 80s-90s while relative humidities dropped in the teens to 20s. Winds were breezy, gusting up to 30 mph in southeast Oregon. Scattered precipitation fell in western Washington. No lightning was recorded. Initial attack was light with the largest new start growing to 100 acres in grass in central Washington. Existing large fires showed moderate to active fire behavior and light growth.
