High temperatures east of the Cascades were in the 70s and 80s with isolated 90s in eastern Oregon. West of the Cascades high temperatures were in the 60s and 70s. Minimum relative humidities east of the Cascades were in the single digits to low teens from the Blue Mountains south and 20 to 30s north of the Blues. Humidities were above 40 for the rest of the Geographic Area. Breezy, gusty conditions occurred east of the Cascades with windy conditions in southeast Oregon. Moderate lightning occurred across the Cascades and west central Oregon. Moderate to heavy precipitation occurred in the Oregon cascades, light to moderate rainfall was recorded in western Washington and Oregon. Initial attack was light. Existing large fires exhibited low fire behavior.
