WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

High temperatures were in the 70s and 80s across most of the area with 60s being recorded along the coast and northwestern Washington. Relative humidities were in the 20s and 30s in most locations. Northwest Washington had values in the 50s to 70s. Winds were breezy in the Columbia Gaps and southeastern Oregon, light and variable elsewhere. There was scattered precipitation in northwest Washington. None was recorded across the rest of the Geographic Area. There was scattered lightning in northwest Washington. Initial attack was light. Little growth occurred on existing large fires.
