Temperatures rose 5-10 degrees with most of the geographic area in the high 80s to low 100s. Relative humidity dropped 5-15 percent with the east side dipping to the single digits and teens while the west side stayed above 30 percent. Poor overnight relative humidity recovery in southeast Oregon. Winds were breezy, gusting up to 30 mph in Harney Basin. Isolated precipitation along the southern Oregon Coast. No lightning reported. Initial attack was light with all fires remaining under 10 acres. Existing large fires showed an increase in activity.
