WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

The warming and drying trend will peak today west of the Cascades and on Sunday east of the Cascades. Temperatures will be above normal until Monday when a brief cooling trend arrives. General winds will be light across the region today and then increasing from the west to southwest along the east slopes of the Oregon Cascades late Sunday. Poor overnight humidity recovery is likely over elevated terrain exposed to thermal belt conditions. Cumulus buildups are likely over the southern Oregon Cascades today with isolated thunderstorms spreading north on Sunday and Monday.
