**WEATHER HIGHLIGHT**

Temperatures rose 2-7 degrees in some areas of the geographic area with highs on the west side in the low 90s and above 100 on the east side. Relative humidity was above 35 percent on the west side while on the east side it dropped 0-5 percent into the single digits and teens. Winds were light, gusting up to 25 mph on the east side in areas. Isolated precipitation (less than .02") occurred along the central Oregon coast. Lightning activity was light and occurred to south central Oregon. Initial attack activity was light and all fires remaining under 20 acres. Existing large fires showed moderate growth and moderate fire behavior.
