Weather conditions moderated across the geographic area with temperatures dropping 10-20 degrees and relative humidity rose 5-20 percent in the Cascades and east side of the Cascades. Winds were light on the west side of the Cascades and breezy on the east side with gusts up to 22 mph. Light to moderate precipitation occurred in the Oregon Cascades, parts of eastern Oregon and Washington, and the Olympic Peninsula. Lightning activity was light and concentrated in south central Oregon. There were 10 new fires for 124 acres. Current fires showed little growth with moderate fire behavior.
