WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures were in the 80-90s east of the Cascades and in southwest Oregon while the remainder of the west side stayed in the 60-70s. Relative humidity east of the Cascades dropped below 20 percent with single digits in southeast Oregon while the west side stayed above 30 percent. Poor overnight humidity recovery in southeast Oregon. Winds were breezy with gusts up to 40 mph in the Yakima Valley and southeast Oregon. Light lightning recorded in the eastern Washington and far northeast Oregon. No precipitation recorded. Initial attack was light with all starts remaining under 1 acre. Existing large fires showed active fire behavior.
