Temperatures across the Geographic Area were in the 80s to mid-90s. Relative humidity east of the Cascades and southwest of Oregon dropped below 20 percent with southeast Oregon reaching single digits. Relative humidity west of the cascades remained above 30 percent. Overnight humidity recovery was moderate in the east side basins and poor in the Harney Basin. Winds were breezy with gusts up to 35 mph in the Okanogan Valley. No precipitation or lightning was recorded. Initial attack was light with the largest new start growing to 25 acres in grass in northeast Washington. Active fire behavior reported on existing large fires.
