WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Temperatures were in the 80s to the mid-90s across the Geographic Area. Relative humidity dropped to the single digits in southeast Oregon, teens for the remainder of the east side and 30-40 percent for the west side. Overnight humidity recovery was moderate across the east side and poor in the Harney Basin. Winds were breezy gusting up to 30 in the Columbia Gorge. Light lightning was accompanied by scattered precipitation across northern Washington. Initial attack was light with all fires remaining under 5 acres. Existing large fires showed active fire behavior with those close to containment showing minimal fire behavior.
