WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

High pressure returns today bringing significant warming, drying, and low-level instability. The thermal trough over western PSAs brings strong ventilation potential to fires in the Cascades and moderate ventilation potential elsewhere. Decreasing humidity recovery for all areas plus easterly flow for western PSAs will prolong fuel drying periods. Mainly dry thunderstorms are possible across southern Oregon Friday but are more likely Saturday. Areas further north may also see storms. These storms could produce moderate lightning counts along with strong outflow wind. Slow moving low pressure will push toward the coast beginning Sunday. Dry gusty winds, particularly across southeast Oregon, will increase through Monday while rain begins to fall west of the Cascades.
