WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Hot, dry, and unstable weather will shift mainly to the east side today as a gradual cooling trend begins. Thunderstorms will move from central Oregon today into northeastern Oregon today before shifting out of the area tonight. Poor overnight humidity over the Cascades will begin to recover until Sunday when cooler air with more moisture begins working inland from the coast. General winds will begin increasing on Sunday along the east slopes of the Cascades as the cooling trend continues. Some light rain may be possible by midweek next week.
