Showers taper off today as high pressure starts building offshore. Expect mild weather, lowering humidity plus daily west breezes through the Cascade gaps until at least Saturday. Significant model inconsistency prevails for Sunday's forecast and beyond. Some solutions further build the ridge over the Northwest bringing hot and dry weather while most solutions keep it flatter. Flatter solutions allow periodic weather systems, rain chances from northern Oregon northward and locally gusty winds. Stay tuned as the forecast continues to evolve.
