Maximum temperatures were in the 60s and 70s across the area with isolated 80s in southwest Oregon. Minimum relative humidities were in the teens and 20s east of the Cascades and over 30 west. Light variable breezes occurred across the area. No lightning was recorded. isolated light precipitation was recorded west of the Cascades. Initial attack was light. Fire behavior was active on the Bachelor Complex and low to moderate on other large fires.
