WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

A thermal trough builds north along the I-5 corridor today and tomorrow. Expect breezy winds for areas west of the Cascade crest through Tuesday. Wednesday, high pressure exits the region eastward while low pressure fills in behind. Rain falls mainly over western Washington along with isolated thunderstorms. Little rain falls east of the crest. A marine push brings moderately strong winds through the Cascade gaps and lower Columbia Basin. Drier southwest general winds also strengthen across south-central and southeast Oregon. Mild weather under westerly flow returns heading into the weekend. Another drier system crosses Saturday night and Sunday.
