WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Low pressure crosses the Geographic Area today. A marine push brings moderately strong winds through the Cascade gaps and across the Columbia Basin. Drier southwest general winds also strengthen across south-central and southeast Oregon. Rain and isolated thunderstorms expected mostly over western Washington and northwest Oregon. Some rain and isolated drier thunderstorms also possible east of the Cascades. Most wind will dramatically weaken by midnight tonight. Mild weather under westerly flow returns heading into the weekend. Another system crosses Saturday but is much weaker and drier. High pressure builds Sunday and Monday.
