Maximum temperatures in were in the 60-70s across most of the Geographic Area. Relative humidity east of the Cascades and southwestern Oregon dropped to the 20-30s while the west side stayed above 40 percent. Winds were light across Oregon and breezier in Washington with gusts up to 30-40 mph in the Olympic Mountains and north central Washington. Precipitation was light to moderate in western Washington and scattered in northwest Oregon. No lightning recorded. Initial attack was light with all new starts remaining less than 2 acres. Minimal to moderate fire behavior observed on existing large fires.
