West of the Cascades saw relative humidities above 35 percent while the east side fell to the teens. Poor to moderate overnight humidity recovery in southeastern Oregon. Conditions were windy east of the Cascades with gusting into the 40s in the Columbia Basin. Scattered precipitation fell in northwestern Washington. No lightning recorded. Initial attack was light with the largest new start growing to 20 acres in the Columbia Basin. Uncontained portions of existing large fires showed moderate to active fire behavior fire behavior.
