WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Expect dry weather across the geographic area today with light northerly general winds in most locations. Poor humidity recovery this morning with some light easterly winds are likely over the Cascades of Oregon and again tonight. However, during the burning period on Friday general winds will switch to southwest and increase as a cold front approaches the Cascades and crosses to the east side. Rain is expected with the frontal system in western Washington and northwest Oregon but east of the Cascades gusty southwest to south winds are expected early in the day becoming westerly after front passage during the afternoon. Little, if any, rain is expected in the basins east of the Cascades.
