A cold front will move over the region today. General winds will switch to southwest to south and increase while becoming strong and gusty as the front crosses the Cascades and moves to the Idaho border by afternoon. General winds will switch more to west and remain strong with the frontal passage east of the Cascades. Rain is expected with the front in western Washington and northwest Oregon but in the basins east of the Cascades little rain is expected.
