WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Maximum temperatures reached the 80s in southern Oregon and 60-70s elsewhere. Minimum relative humidity dropped to the teens in eastern Oregon, 20s in southwestern Oregon and eastern Washington and stayed above 40 percent in western Washington and northwest Oregon. Winds were breezy across the region gusting into the 30s in the Cascade gaps. No precipitation or lightning recorded. Initial attack was light with all new starts remaining under a quarter acre. Existing large fires saw an increase in activity towards the end of the burn period.
