WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Maximum temperatures reached the low 90s in southwestern Oregon and 70-80s elsewhere. Minimum relative humidity dropped to the teens in southwestern and eastern Oregon, 20s in eastern Washington and stayed above 30 percent in western Washington and northwest Oregon. Winds were breezy across the region gusting into the 20s in south central Oregon. Precipitation was limited to coastal drizzle in Washington and northern Oregon. Isolated lightning was recorded in the southeast corner of Oregon. Initial attack was light with the Pine Fire growing to 2,000 acres. Existing large fires saw increasing activity in the afternoon.
