WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Maximum temperatures reached the 70-80s east of the Cascades and in southwest Oregon. Minimum relative humidity dropped to the teens in eastern Oregon, 20s in southwest Oregon and eastern Washington and above 30 percent elsewhere. Winds were breezy across the region gusting into the 20s in southeast Oregon and through the Cascade gaps. Light to moderate precipitation was recorded in western Washington and northwest Oregon. No lightning was recorded. Initial attack was light. Existing large fires experienced moderate to active afternoon fire behavior.
