WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

High pressure builds westward across the Geographic Area through the weekend. Dry weather is expected through the weekend, locally breezy north winds occur Thursday on both sides of the Cascades. Weak offshore upper low pressure undercuts the ridge and moves across Oregon through the weekend. Minimal rain chances expected for southern Oregon on Saturday with gusty southwest wind potential for southern Oregon. A much deeper upper low arrives Monday and Tuesday, bringing west side rain, eastside breezes and minimal hope for east side showers.
