WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Maximum temperatures were generally in the 60s and 70s with only two stations reaching 80 degrees. Minimum relative humidities were in the high teens and 20s east of the Cascades, isolated teens were recorded in western Washington and generally above 30 elsewhere. Light breezes occurred east of the Cascades with stronger gusts in the 30s in southern Oregon. Scattered precipitation occurred in southwest Oregon and northwest Washington. No lightning was recorded. Initial attack was light. Existing large fires experienced light to moderate afternoon fire behavior.
