**WEATHER HIGHLIGHT**

High pressure slowly gives way to low pressure approaching from the northwest over the next few days. Rain arrives to western Washington and north coastal Oregon today, with more showers spreading inland Tuesday. A cold front arrives Wednesday with rain and snow showers spreading eastward Thursday. Full Cascade rain shadowing will be in effect for the high desert and rangelands as they may struggle to receive wetting precipitation this week, while the eastern mountains will receive notably more rain and snow. Another front arrives some time Friday night through Saturday night. Gusty west winds at times east of the Cascades, particularly Wednesday, though generally under cooler temperatures and higher humidity.
