WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

A cold front crosses the Geographic Area today bringing soaking rain to most of western Oregon and Washington plus the far northeast Oregon mountains. Relatively light rain is expected elsewhere. Showers continue Thursday with snow levels lowering below 5000 feet in places. Wet thunderstorms expected tonight and Thursday. Also, west winds become moderately strong at times today and Thursday east of the Cascades, though generally under cooler temperatures and higher humidity. Friday through Sunday has an atmospheric river soaking Western Washington. Relatively little rain is also expected east of the Cascades from that system.
