**WEATHER HIGHLIGHT**

Low pressure continues to bring showers, thunderstorms and lowering snow levels today. Moderately gusty west winds continue today east of the Cascades, but with higher humidity to offset the threat. Skies clear out Thursday night with a first freeze expected for many areas east of the Cascades. Friday through Sunday has an atmospheric river soaking western Washington and lower amounts for western Oregon. Relatively little rain expected for most eastside areas. Low pressure cuts off the northern California coast next week resulting in cooler temperatures and mainly dry weather.
