WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

Today through Sunday has an atmospheric river bringing a multi-inch soaking rain for western Washington. Lower amounts expected for western Oregon though locally up to an inch by Monday morning. Relatively little rain expected for most eastside areas though the eastern mountains could get a decent wetting rain as a cold front eventually crosses Sunday night and Monday. Breezy winds expected Sunday and Monday surrounding the cold front. Low pressure cuts off the northern California coast next week resulting in cooler temperatures and mainly dry weather.
