WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

The frontal system crossing the region today will provide clouds and rain this morning with intermittent showers this afternoon for most of the region except southeast Oregon. Gusty southwest to west general winds are expected over much of eastern Oregon and southeastern Washington today with the passage of the frontal system. Drying is expected on Tuesday with lighter winds. Another frontal system will take shape on Wednesday with rain and gusty winds developing mainly over central and eastern Oregon. Drying returns again Thursday and Friday with the potential for some gusty east winds on the west side.
