WEATHER HIGHLIGHT

West of the Cascades, temperatures remained in the 50s to 60s with wind gusts into the 20s and moderate to heavy precipitation. East of the Cascades, temperatures rose into the 60s to 70s, relative humidity dropped to the teens and 20s, wind gusts peaked in the 50s, and scattered precipitation was observed. Scattered lightning occurred across the Geographic Area. Initial attack remained light with the largest fire growing to 178 acres in central Washington.
