RESTRICTIONS

PROHIBITED



All open burning and campfires. This includes fires in rock fire pits and metal fire rings.



Wood and charcoal fires, including charcoal grills, and wood-fired stoves, smokers, and portable braziers.



Operating a chainsaw, blowtorch, or the cutting, grinding, or welding of metal.



Tracer, incendiary, and steel component ammunition and the shooting of metal targets.



Fireworks and other pyrotechnic and incendiary devices.



All explosives, including exploding targets.



Sky lanterns and other aerial luminaries.

PERMITTED



Liquefied gas fueled devices, such as stoves, heaters, smokers, portable braziers, and grills are allowed but require 10 feet of clearance from flammable vegetation. Generators are also allowed but require clearance. Use caution when filling/igniting.



Safe shooting is allowed. Avoid shooting in dry grass and on hot, dry, and windy days. Hard targets are more likely to cause a spark.



Smoking is allowed only in vehicles or boats or in areas with 6 foot of clearance. Dispose of butts properly.



The use of E vehicles is allowed. All motorized vehicles are permitted on clean roads and ways only. Maintain spark arrestors and stay off dry grass. Keep your under-carriage clean. Internal combustion powered vehicles over 46 inches wide or over 800 pounds must have a 26" shovel and 1 gallon of water or a 2.5-pound fire extinguisher.
